



Make sure that when entering Immunizations on PROMIS that you are using the **PROMIS State Schedule**

**One Copy of each child’s PROMIS Immunization Record goes in Center’s Immunization binder for Childcare License.**

**Updated Guidance for the following Immunizations:**

- **Hepatitis A- the 2<sup>nd</sup> Hep A is required at age 22-24 months.** If child is over age 24 months, and they don’t have the 2<sup>nd</sup> Hep A, they will need to update their vaccine or file an exempt form. Use Conditional Attendance Form to allow 2 weeks for family to update vaccines. Please check IRIS first.
- **Hib- 2 doses are required if older than 12 months.**
- **Pneumococcal- 2 doses are required for all children if over 4 months of age.**

**There is one vaccine that is not given after a certain age. Please see the following:**

- **Rotavirus-** Is not given to children over 8 months of age. If the child is over 8 months of age, and didn’t complete the vaccine requirements --change status to **unknown**
- **Varicella-**this vaccine is due at age 12 months and the 2<sup>nd</sup> dose at age 5-7 years.
- If the child has had the chickenpox (disease), then parents must complete the **(pink) Exemption Form**. Check the box  Varicella Disease History, initial & date, then on the back of the form, under **Philosophical Exemption** state the reason: child has had chickenpox (Varicella) disease.

**Children that are behind on any of the required Immunizations:**

If a child has at least one dose of each required vaccine, parents can request two weeks to catch up on vaccines by signing an **Idaho Conditional Attendance to Child Care Form, (yellow)**. **The Center Supervisor will need to sign this form.** If parents fail to update vaccines by the date listed, the child may be excluded from class/socializations, unless the parent signs an Exemption form.

**Exemptions:** A parent may refuse to immunize due to medical, religious or philosophical reasons by completing a **Idaho Certificate of Immunization Exemption form (pink)**. The form must be signed by parent(s), entered into the PROMIS system, one copy to child’s file and one copy to **Heath Specialist. Once Copy to Center’s Immunization Binder for Child Care License.**
