The EPSDT program of the centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services (CMS) requires a blood lead screening to be performed on all Medicaid eligible children and children enrolled in Head Start/ Early Head Start programs beginning at age 12 months, then again at age 24 months, and if not tested during those times, 90 days from enrollment into Head Start.
